Summer Studio Piano Lessons

MUSIC FOR MOPPETS (4-5 year olds) provides a pleasurable environment for children to experience and explore music together, while gradually and thoroughly acquiring a firm command of musical fundamentals and mastery of piano skills. This unique program incorporates piano orientation with playing, singing, creative movement, dramatic play, rhythmic activities and artwork.

2 - 45 minute sessions per week. \$115/per term

KINDER-KEYBOARD (6-7 year olds)

A piano course specifically geared to the abilities and interests of 6 and 7 year olds. Our approach takes advantage of this age group's natural desire to learn in a fun and encouraging atmosphere.

2 - 60 minute sessions per week. \$135/per term

PIANO (ages 8+)

Students enjoy learning with friends while developing comprehensive piano skills through which they can create their own music and recreate that of other composers. Includes sight reading, ear training, keyboard harmony, theory, technique, repertoire, and improvisation.

1 - 75 minute session per week \$90/per term

ADULT PIANO

Teaches facility in reading and playing music of varying styles, basic chord progressions, harmonization, ear training, and theory. Offers many opportunities for creative improvisation and ensemble experiences.

45 minute Private \$105 / 1 Hr. Group \$80/per term

EXPLORING AMERICAN MUSICALS

Students 7-13 years old are invited to join us at **Exploring American Musicals Camp**, August 10-14, at The Lake Shore Music Studio. The objective is to introduce piano students to the repertoire, construction and basic themes of classic American Musical Theatre. The daily activities will include: watching and discussing several musicals on DVD/video; learning to play piano pieces from musicals arranged at a level appropriate to each student's performance ability; group and solo singing; enacting short scenes from musicals as related to the songs performed, and finally a field trip to a live musical performance.

The 5 day program will emphasize musicals with age appropriate themes that feature children. Students may also share pieces they know and experiences they have had with other musicals. In this way participants will be introduced to a wide variety of musical theater options which will inspire them to continue their exploration throughout the year.
